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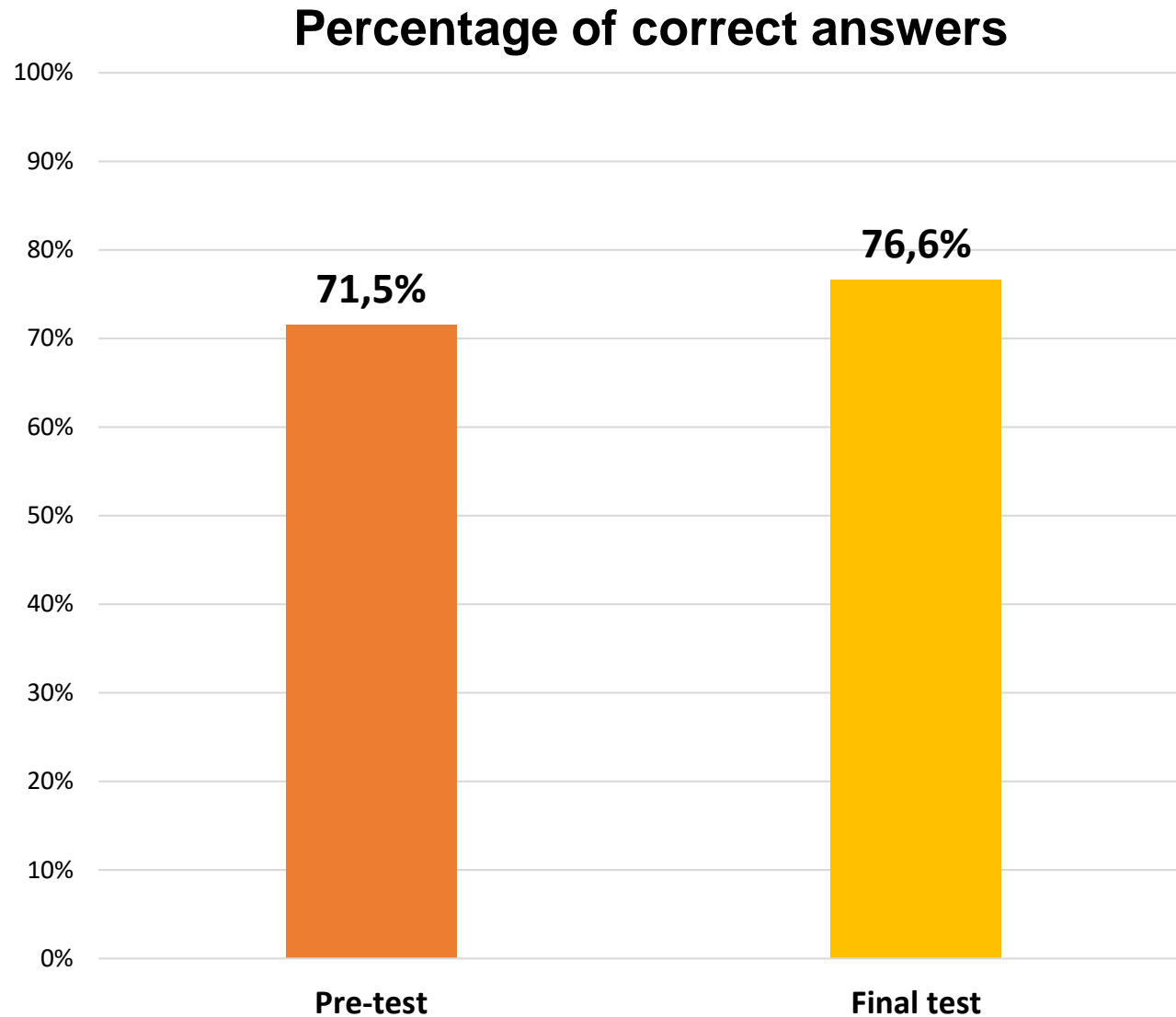

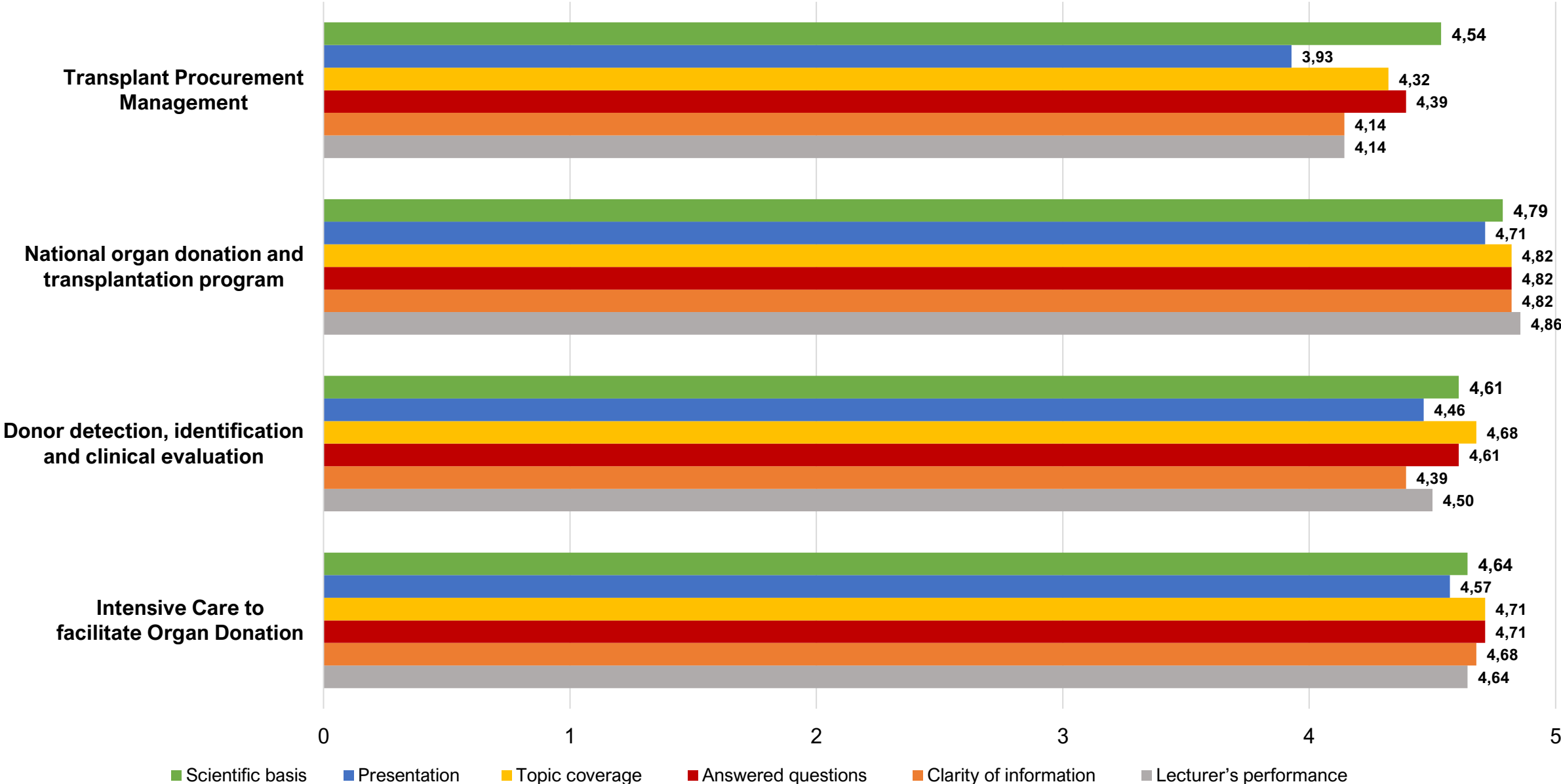

# Did the training provide what you expected to learn?

## Please explain your answer

# Was there anything in this course that could be improved?

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- **Timing** of the program (on the first day it should begin in the morning with some more time in the evening).
- The first lecture was very poor due to technical problems.
- Perhaps if it was just a bit longer, or else ended sooner in the evening so that there would **be more time to study/review in the evening.**
- The **punctuality of lecturers.**
- **More discussions about clinical cases.**
- Emphasis should be made about the **legal framework of the hosting country.**
- There was a lot of discussion during the lecture about communication. I would prefer for the lecturer to finish and then open a discussion otherwise the point of lecture was somehow lost.
- **More practical knowledge** - the online game should have more cases!
- If something is added to the course, it should be **longer in duration.**
- Problems running the **GoD game.**
