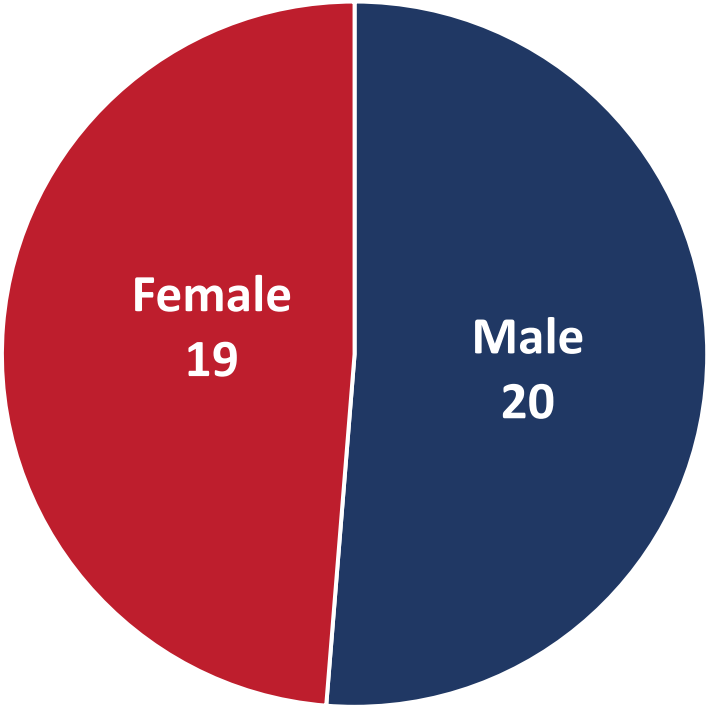

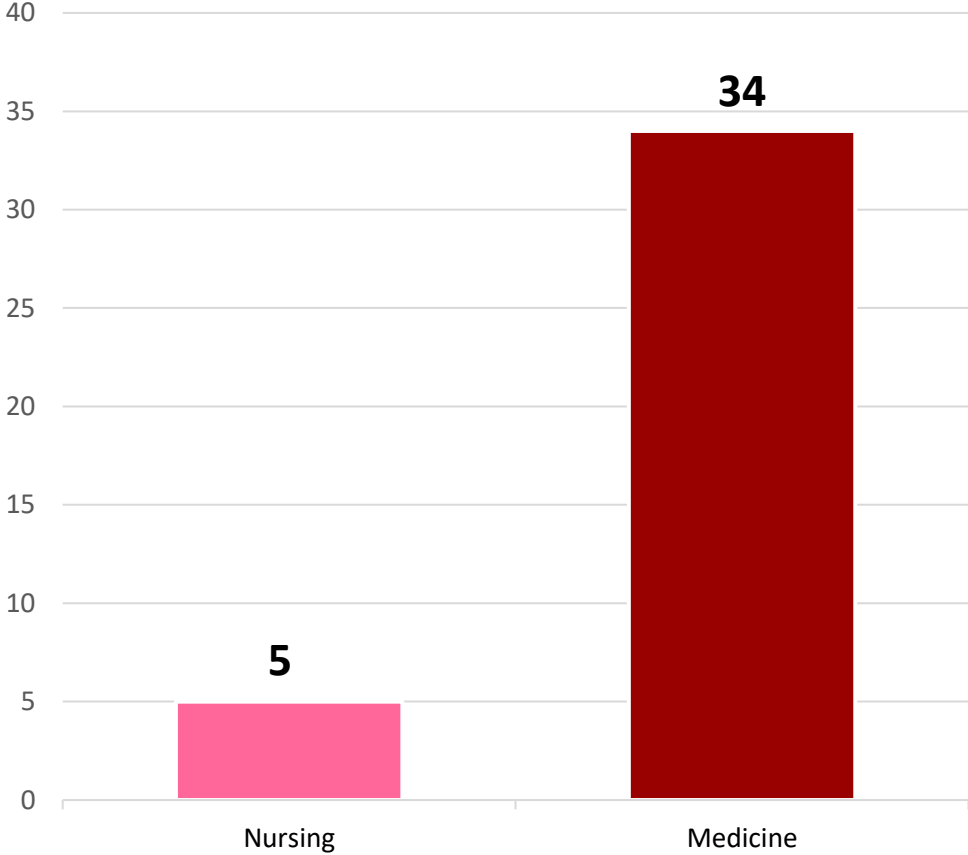

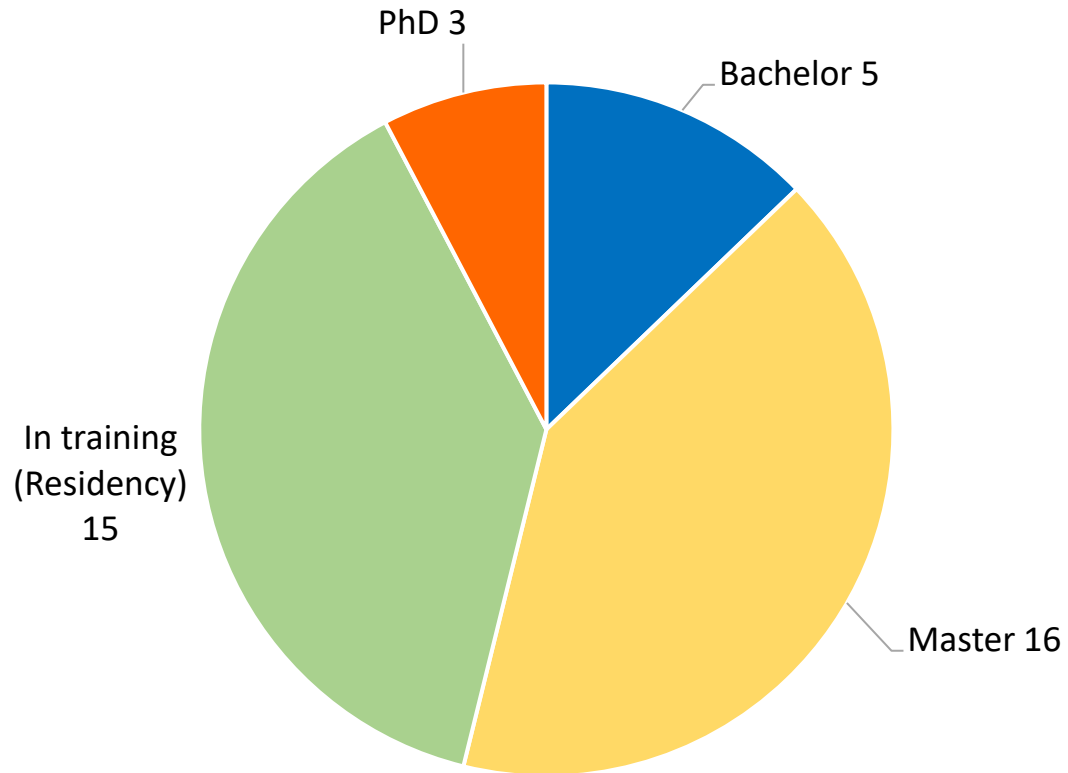
Area of Study



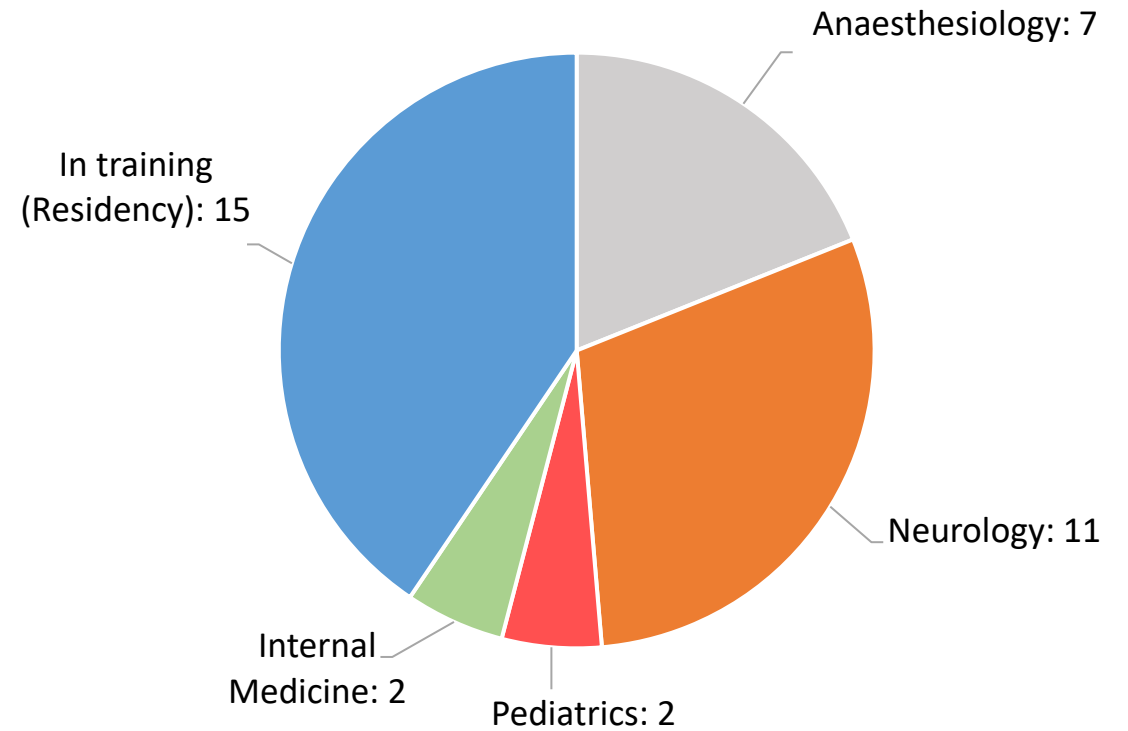

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## Academic Degree



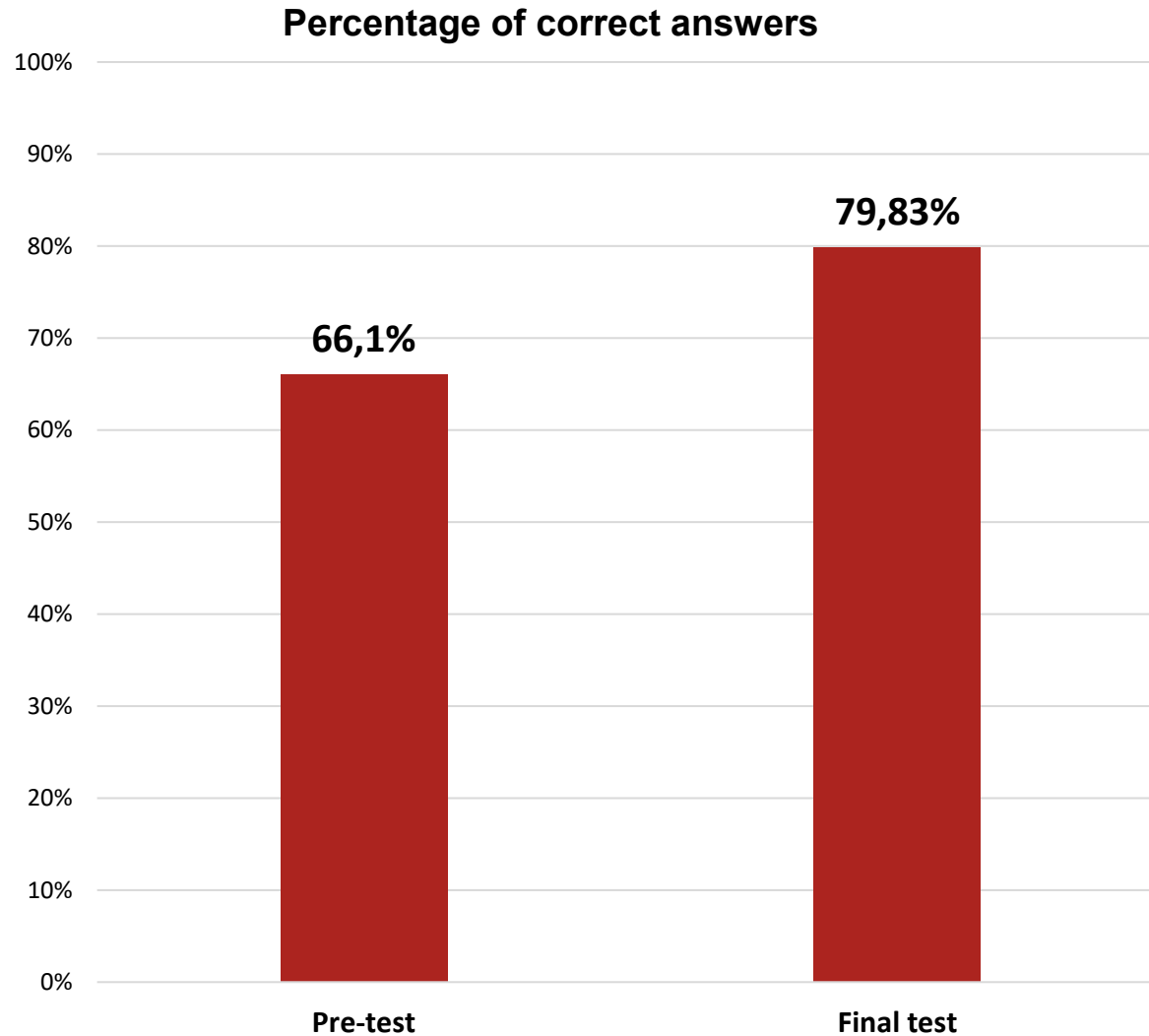

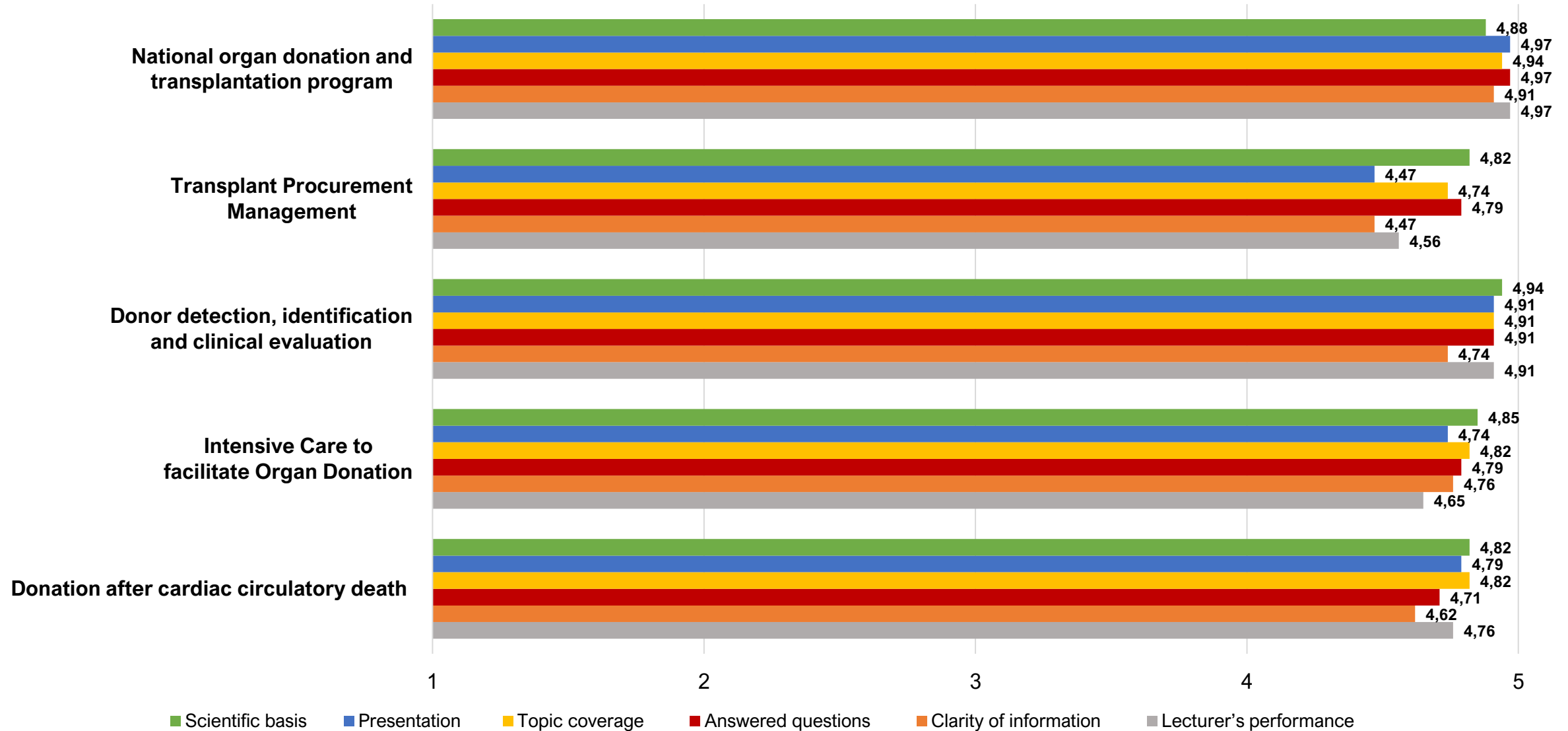

# Did the training provide what you expected to learn?

## Please explain your answer

- More coverage of how exactly TPM does his/her work. More about how the suitability of organs for transplantation is evaluated.
- More "family approach" time.

# What was the best aspect of this training?

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- The group discussions and peer interactions were the best part. It was great to hear different perspectives and learn from others' experiences.
- I appreciated getting more detailed information about the donation process from the aspect of organization as well as medical aspects in maintaining potential donor, multiorgan recovery and new information about DCD, which we do not have yet in our country.
- Workshops in small groups with direct communication between the faculty.

# Was there anything in this course that could be improved?

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- Maybe even more clinical cases in the workshops.
- All in all, a good course regarding the educational program, but the social program was a bit lackluster.
- Some of the topics were not that easy to understand for me as an PICU Nurse. You also need some knowledge before the course.
- Maybe a little bit more information about children as potential donors.
